



## 20 Years of My Health eVet



**1999** The My Health eVet platform is piloted at 9 VA Medical Centers across the country. It is a pioneer in patient portal technology.



**2003** My Health eVet launches nationally on Veterans Day, featuring health and benefits information, and a health calendar. A personal health record is added soon after.



**2005** Veterans can now request VA prescription refills online. Today, My Health eVet receives over 2 million refill requests per month.



**2008** Secure Messaging launches. This enables Veterans to exchange secure online messages with members of their VA care team.



**2010** The VA Blue Button feature is added to My Health eVet. Veterans can view, download, or print their VA health records.



**2017** My Health eVet debuts its online VA appointment scheduling tool.



**2018** The VA Medical Images and Reports feature launches. Veterans can view, download, and share electronic copies of their radiology studies.



**2019** My Health eVet's pharmacy features are made available to CHAMPVA beneficiaries.



**2021** Shared Vitals launches. This feature enables Veterans to share their vital sign readings with their VA care team.



**2023** My Health eVet begins moving to its new home on VA.gov. This will enable Veterans to manage their VA health care on the same website where they access benefits and services.
